# TOURNAMENT RULES

*All participants must show current (2011-12) USBC membership card or copy thereof.*

1. Tournament will consist of Mixed Team Event (2 men & 2 women) and Mixed Doubles (1 man & 1 woman) and a separate optional six game All Events for men and women.
2. All prizes will be on a handicap basis. The handicap shall be computed on an individual basis of ninety percent (90%) of the difference of an entrant's entering average and 220 scratch.
3. Entering average:
  - a. 2010-11 highest USBC winter league average of 21 or more games.
  - b. If no winter average last year, use highest current season USBC average as of Jan. 1, 2012 for 21 or more games.
  - c. Bowlers with neither of the above averages must bowl scratch.
  - d. If current season average for at least 21 games at the time of bowling exceeds entering average by 10 or more pins, current season average must be used (Rule 319a, item 2).
4. It is each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their own average in handicap or classified tournaments, whether originally submitted by the bowlers, the team captain or others. Failure to use the correct average may disqualify the score if submitted average is lower than correct average, thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winnings will be based on the submitted average, if it is higher than the correct average. (Rule 310a, item 3).
5. Reporting of previous tournament winnings will not apply. (Rule 319d). The average adjustment rule will apply. (Rule 319e).
6. Multiple participation:
  - a. Team Event-Bowlers must change two people each time you participate in team event. The same two men and the same two women cannot bowl together on the same team more than once.
  - b. Doubles-Must change partners when participating more than one time.
  - c. Only exception from bowling multiple times is above rules 6(a) and 6(b). You can bowl as many times as you want as long as you change partners.
  - d. You can bowl with as many different teams as you want provided you follow rule 6(a).
  - e. All Events: ONE TIME ONLY! First time bowled in Team & Doubles will count towards all events.
7. Individuals who are members of bowling organizations identified as "professional" are eligible for participation, however, not more than one professional bowler may compete on a four member team or Doubles team.
8. Report all substitutions to the Tournament Office at least 30 minutes prior to scheduled squad time.
9. Unmarried grade and high school students who have not attained the age of eighteen (18) MUST SUBMIT a "Parental Consent Form" with their application. These forms are available from the league secretaries or from the tournament secretary. Parental consent must be submitted to the tournament secretary at least one week before the bowlers will be eligible for tournament play; unless the student is accompanied by his parent or legal Guardian in which case, the parental consent form may be filed up to the time of participation.
10. No changes in team or doubles order of bowling will be permitted after scheduling.
11. Prize Ratio: At least 1 of 8. ALL EVENTS: 1 of 10. Prize fund returned 100%.

We reserve the right to refuse entries.

All entrants must bowl when scheduled and no entry fees will be refunded once the schedule is posted. Team Captains have certified on this entry blank that their team members agree to abide by the rules and regulations of this Tournament.
